Life Skills & SEL Focus

The Leadership Academy focuses on SEL and life skills in a digestible format for our youth. We spark the minds of our youth and provide them opportunities they may not receive elsewhere. The vocational training includes culinary arts, etiquette classes, music recording and production, Carpentry, plumbing, fishing, archery, kayaking, branding, podcast production, and more. Our guest speaker series connects students with notable figures in our community. Some guest speakers will cover topics such as Credit 101, Home Ownership, Software Development, and more. Our curriculum caters to social support and effective decision-making. Class covers topics such as Anger management, how to avoid peer pressure, Development of social skills, the art of communication, and so much more. The Leadership Academy mitigates opioid use and gun violence by offering our youth an alternative program unique to the region. Our after-school program ranges from 2 to 3 days a week, and our summer camp schedule is four days a week. Meals, snacks, and transportation are provided at no cost to our families.




